(1) 転学

現在、高校に在学している生徒が、引き続き他の高校の相当学年に移ることをいいます。 同一課程間・同一学科間を原則としますが、第1学年の第二学期の募集では、異なる課程・ 異なる学科に応募することができます。ただし、転学後、卒業に必要な単位の履修及び修得 が可能であると志願先の都立高校長が認める場合は、第1学年の第三学期以降の募集におい ても、異なる課程・異なる学科に応募することができます。

2 Regarding transfer/transfer admission to metropolitan high schools (part-time/correspondence courses)

Tokyo metropolitan high schools conduct [Transfer and Transfer Application admissions] every semester. The number of applicants for each high school will be posted on the website of the Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education at the recruitment period. Schools that offer transfer/transfer admissions the required documents vary, so please contact the high school where you will be taking the test directly. Also, at the same time, please request the necessary documents.

(1) Transfer

This refers to students who are currently enrolled in high school continuing to move to the equivalent grade level at another high school. In principle, students may apply to the same course or department, but in the second semester of the first year, students may apply to different courses or departments. However, if the principal of the metropolitan high school to which the student is applying recognizes that the student will be able to complete and earn the credits necessary for graduation after transferring, the student may apply to a different program or department in the third semester of the first year or later.

Recruitment period is three times a year (March, August, December).

Application qualifications

Currently enrolled high school students who have an address or place of employment in Tokyo or who are certain to have an address or place of employment in Tokyo by the date of enrollment.

O Documents to be submitted

- Application form for transfer/transfer admissions (distributed by the high school to which you are applying)
- •Identification that can confirm the applicant's address or place of employment (certificate of items listed in residence card, certificate of employment, etc.)
- ·Transfer inquiry form and certificate of enrollment
- ·Certificate of Credit Acquisition and transcript of results
- •Other, documents specified by the principal to which you are applying.
- •Entrance examination fee for part-time courses and correspondence courses: 950 yen (payable in cash)

(2) Transfer admission

This refers to enrollment from a different type of school or completion of more than one year of high school and then re-enrollment in a second or higher grade after leaving high school.

Application qualifications

A person who falls under either of the following a or b.

- a. Applicants must withdrew from high school after earning credits equivalent to or higher than the first grade at high school and have a residence or place of employment in Tokyo, or be certain to have a residence or place of employment in Tokyo by the date of admission (applications are accepted once a year in in(March)).
- b. Persons enrolled in the upper division of a secondary education school, the high school of a technical college or a special needs school, etc. (Recruitment period is 3 times a year (March, August, December))
- O Documents to be submitted
 - •Application form for transfer/transfer admissions (distributed by the high school of a technical college or a special needs school, etc.
 - ·Identification that can confirm the applicant's address or place of employment (certificate of items listed in residence card, certificate of employment, etc.)
 - ·Certificate of credits earned from the last school attended
 - ·Other, documents specified by the principal to which you are applying.
 - •Entrance examination fee for part-time courses and correspondence courses: 950 yen (payable in cash)

3 Frequently asked questions

(1) To apply for new first year students

[Question 1](Planning to move from another prefecture)

I currently live in another prefecture, but after graduating from junior high school, I have been living with my father, who is working alone in Tokyo. I would like to attend a metropolitan high school, but are I eligible to apply for part-time courses?

[Answer] Since the applicant will be residing in Tokyo, he/she is eligible to apply for the part-time course.

[Question 2] (Payment of entrance examination fee from outside of Tokyo)

If I am taking the test from outside Tokyo, how should I pay the entrance examination fee?

[Answer] For online applications, credit card payment can be made on the application website. If you use a payment slip, payment can be made at "Tokyo Metropolitan Government Public Finance Collection Agencies (refer to the website of the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Accounting Office)" even if you are outside of Tokyo. If you are unable to pay at a financial institution due to closing hours or other reasons, please pay in cash at the counter of the high school you wish to attend when you submit your application form.

(2) To transfer/transfer admissions

[Question 3] (Transfer between the same courses)

I am enrolled in the first year of a part-time courses, but can I apply for transfer/transfer admission to the full-time courses?

[Answer] It is possible to transfer if you pass the application for transfer/admission (see page 12), which is held every semester. For details, please contact the high school of your choice.

[Question 4] (Transfer between different courses)

I am enrolled in the first year of a part-time courses, but can I apply for transfer/transfer admission to the full-time courses?

[Answer] In principle, students must apply to the same course and department as before their transfer, but in the second semester of the first year, students may apply to a different course and department. For applications after the third semester of first year, students may apply to a different program or department if the principal of the metropolitan high school to which the student is transferring approves that the student is capable of completing the credits required for graduation after the transfer.

The same applies to transfers from correspondence courses.

[Question 5] (Transfer/transfer admission from Miscellaneous School)

Can I apply for part-time courses from assistant nursing schools (Miscellaneous School)?

[Answer] It is not possible to transfer or transfer admission from Specialized Training College or Miscellaneous School.

[Question 6] (Transfer admission of students who dropped out during the the school year)

I have dropped out of the first year of the regular course. Can I apply for the transfer/transfer admission program after the second semester?

[Answer] Students who have not earned credits equivalent to or higher than the first grade are not eligible to apply for transfer/transfer admission. However, it is possible to apply for the next entrance exam (new first year students).

[Question 7] (Apply for transfer admission with subjects passed in the high school equivalency examination (former Daiken))

In addition to credits earned in high school, can I apply for transfer/transfer admission by taking courses for which I have passed the high school equivalency examination (formerly known as the Daiken) as credits earned?
