5 都立高等学校の入試について



- Q1 都立高校には様々なタイプの学校があるようですが、各高校の特色を知るにはどうしたらよいですか。
- A1 各学校のホームページの他に、都立高校等検索サイトや都立学校魅力PR動画「まなびゅ〜」を 活前することで、各高校の特色や魅力を知ることができます。ぜひ活前してみてください。
- Q2 推薦入試で必ず実施される、個人而接について教えてください。
- A2 個人面接では、出願の動機・理能、興味・関心、高校生活に対する意欲、適性、規範意識・生活態度や自己PRカードの記載内容、や学校における様々な活動の状況及び将来の進路希望などを確かめたり、質問の内容を酌確に把握し適切に応答する能力や表現力などを評価したりします。また、これまでの経験を学後の高校生活に生かすことができる力があるかなどを確認します。
- Q3 推薦入試の集団討論の内容を教えてください。
- A3 集団討論では、コミュニケーション能力や協調性、思考力、判断力、表現力などを評価します。与えられたテーマについて自分の考えを明確に述べることができるか、複数的の受検生同士が協力して一つのテーマに関して議論を進めて結論を導くことができるかなどを確認します。

学級活動の時間に話し合いをしたことや、各教科の授業時間に皆で意覚交換をしたことがあると思います。その経験を生かし、「自分自身の考え・意見をしっかりともつこと」、「相手の考えを理解した上で、自分の考えを前確に相手に伝えること」などを意識して覧んでください。

なお、集団討論の形態には、「節接管が司会役となって議論を進めていく形」や「受検生だけで 首主的に議論を進めていく形」があります。どの形態で行うかは、各高校が決めることになります。

5 Tokyo Metropolitan High School Entrance Examinations Frequently Asked Questions

- Q1. There seem to be various types of Tokyo metropolitan high schools. How can I learn the characteristics of each high school?
- A1. You can learn the characteristics and charms of each school by visiting its website. In addition, you can use the search engine for Tokyo metropolitan high schools and watch their promotional videos "Mana-view" introducing the charm of metropolitan schools. Please utilize these resources.
- Q2. Please tell me about the individual interview a required part of the recommendation-based admission screening process.
- **A2.** During the individual interview, candidates will be asked about the reason for applying to the school, their interests and enthusiasm for high school life. The interview will also serve to confirm a candidate's suitability, sense of conscience, attitude toward life, the information provided on the self-introduction card, the various activities he/she has been involved in during junior high school and his/her plans for the future. A candidate's ability to accurately comprehend the questions and express him/herself by responding appropriately will be evaluated. The interviewers will also look at whether the candidate has the ability to apply his/her experiences to his/her future high school life.

Q3. Please tell me about the content of the group discussion of the recommendation-based admission screening process.

- **A3**. During the group discussion, candidates' communication skills, spirit of cooperation and ability to think, make decisions and to express themselves are evaluated. The discussion will also serve to check if they can clearly state their thoughts on a given theme, and if multiple candidates can work together to discuss a theme and draw conclusions.
 - At your school, you must have had discussions during class activities and exchanged opinions during class hours in some subjects. For the group discussion, you should keep in mind to make use of that experience and be aware of "having your own thoughts and opinions firmly" and "understanding the other person's thoughts and accurately communicating your own thoughts to the other person." There are two types of group discussions: one with an interviewer acting as a moderator and facilitating the discussion and the other with candidates alone proceeding with the discussion voluntarily. It is up to each high school to decide which type of discussion to use.
 - * The group discussions may not be held in the AY 2023 entrance examination as a countermeasure against the coronavirus disease as in the previous year. Details will be announced on the Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education website.

Q4 文化・スポーツ等特別推薦とはどのような推薦入試ですか。

A4 管さんが与までつちかってきた運動の技量や芸術的な感性など優れた能力を評価するとともに、 答高校の個性化や特色化を推進するための気試です。

なお、この特別推薦と同時に、同一校の一般推薦にも出願することができます。

※ 令和5年度入試では、新型コロナウイルス感染症対策に関わる特別な対応を行う可能性があります。

Q5 推薦入試で合格できなかった都立高校を、学力検査に基づく入試で再度受検できますか。

A5 受検できます。ただし、推薦入試と間じ学校を受検しても着利になるということはありません。また、他の都立高校に出願し、受検することもできます。

なお、都立高校ではいずれかの入試(推薦、第一次募集・分割前期募集、分割後期募集・第二次 募集)の合格者は、それ以降に行われる入試には出願できません。

Q4. What does the screening process required for special recommendation-based admissions candidates (cultural, sports, etc.)?

A4. Special recommendation-based screening and testing is held, not only to evaluate the outstanding abilities of athletic skills and artistic sensitivity that students have cultivated to date, but also to promote the individuality and speciality of each school in its area.

High schools to conduct special recommendation-based admissions for the AY 2023 will set the areas in which students are to be recruited, the number of available openings and the method of testing based on each individual school's educational activities and area of specialty. This information will be announced in September. The selection will determine the successful candidates who meet criteria decided by each school for each area based on the points earned from the individual interview or group interview, practical test, and essay or composition.

Special recommendation-based admission programs were offered at 92 schools in the AY 2022

Applicants who apply through the special recommendation-based admission process can also apply to the same school through the general recommendation-based admission process at the same time.

* Special measures associated with the coronavirus disease may be taken in the AY 2023.

Q5. Is it possible to reapply to a high school that did not admit me through the recommendation-based admission by taking the academic achievement test-based admission?

A5. Yes, you may do so. However, taking the entrance exam for the same school that you applied for the recommendation-based admission will not give you any advantage over other applicants. Or you may instead apply and take the entrance exam to another Tokyo metropolitan high school.

In addition, please be aware that candidates who have successfully passed any of the Tokyo metropolitan high school entrance examinations (recommendation-based, first round of admissions/first phase of application period, second round of admissions/second phase of application period) will not be eligible to take any

subsequently conducted entrance exams.

- Q6 国際高校に設置されている国際バカロレアコースには、どのような人が応募できますか。 また、どのような検査を実施するのですか。
- A6 中学校を卒業する見込みの方、中学校を卒業した方、海外帰国生徒及び在京外国人生徒で、国際高校の国際バカロレアコースを第一志望とする生徒が応募できます。推薦入試と同じ日に検査を実施するので、他の高校の推薦入試(国際高校を含む。)に出願することはできません。

Q7 学力検査問題を自校で作成する高校について教えてください。

A7 全自制高校のうち以下の10校では、第一次募集・分割前期募集において、学力検査問題を自校で作成します。これらの学校については、自校で作成した問題(国語、数学、英語)と都立高校共通問題(社会、理科)で学力検査を実施します。

なお、国際高校については、英語の学力検査問題のみを自校で作成しています。 また、一部の定時制高校でも、自校で作成した問題により入試を行っています。

Q6. Who is eligible to apply for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme which has been established at Kokusai High School? What kinds of examinations are held?

A6. Among those who are expected to graduate from junior high school, who have graduated from junior high school, who have returned from overseas and who are foreign students residing in Tokyo, those who designate the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme at Kokusai High School as their first choice are eligible to apply. Because the examination is held on the same date as the recommendation-based admissions, the student may not apply simultaneously for a recommendation-based admission of another high school (including Kokusai High School.)

The examination includes an English language skills test, mathematics academic performance test, essay and individual interview.

At the time of application, the applicants may choose in which language you will take each examination, either Japanese or English, except for the English language skills test. Choosing either language will not have any advantage or disadvantage over other applicants.

Q7. Please tell me about the schools which administer academic achievement tests with exam content created by each school on its own or by a group.

A7. Ten of the full-time schools shown below prepare an exam content tailored for each school for the first round of admissions/first phase of the application period. These schools will administer academic achievement tests with content created by each school (Japanese, math and English) in combination with exam questions made by Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education (social studies and science.)

Furthermore, Kokusai High School prepares only the English language portion of the examination on its own.

In addition, some part-time schools also administer entrance examinations using questions prepared on their own.

Q8 入学願書はどのように入手するのですか。

A8 「推薦に基づく込む」及び「学力検査に基づく込む(第一次募集・分割前期募集)」では、原前としてインターネットを通じて出願を行うため、紙の入学願書は必要ありません。やむを得ない事情により、インターネット出願を行うため、紙の入学願書は必要ありません。やむを得ない事情により、インターネット出願を行えない場合の出願方法は、別途ご案内します。「学力検査に基づく入試(分割後期募集・第二次募集)」用の入学願書について、都内公立中学校に在学している方には在学する中学校で配布します。それ以外の方には東京都教育相談センター(郵送対応可)、各都立高校、都庁内にある都立高校入試相談コーナーで配布します。

Q8. How can I obtain an application form?

A8. Applications for recommendation-based admissions and for academic achievement test-based admissions (the first round of admissions/the first phase of application period) should be submitted online in principle. Therefore, a paper application is not required. Those of you who cannot apply online due to unavoidable circumstances will be helped separately.

As for applicants for the second round of admissions/the second phase of application period, the details are as follows:

Applications may be obtained at your school.

Applications may be obtained at the following locations:

- Tokyo Metropolitan Education Consultation Center (may be distributed by postal mail as well.)

Q9 入学願書を提出した後、志望校の変更はできますか。

A9 推薦入試では、志望校を変更することは一切できません。

学力検査に基づく入試では、空間制の都立高校で志望校の変更(散下げ及び再提出)ができます。また、定時制の都立高校のうち、六本木高校、大江声高校、世田谷泉高校、豫がか監高校、桐が正高校、州台橋高校、浅草高校、荻窪高校、八宝子拓資高校及び砂川高校の各置夜間定時制高校においては志望校の変更ができます。

なお、その他の定時制高校の第一次募集では志望校の変更はできません。ただし、定時制高校の第二次募集では志望校の変更ができます。

Q10 インフルエンザ等の学校感染症や新型コロナウイルス感染症にかかり、検査を受検できなかった場合には、何か教済措置がありますか。

- A10 インフルエンザ等の学校感染症や新型コロナウイルス感染症に罹患した場合、新型コロナウイルス感染症への感染が疑われ、受検白境性、濃厚接触者として健康観察や外出自粛を要請されている場合(※) 文はPCR検査の結果を持っている場合は、受検することができません。
 - (※) 濃厚接触者として健康観察や外出首議を要請されている者でも、保健所が紹介した医療機関において、医師の診断により行われるPCR検査の結果、陰性であることなどの案件を満たす場合は、別室での受検ができます。

学力検査に基づく選抜 (第一次募集) を受検することができなかった場合には、申請により、後日行われる「インフルエンザ等学校感染症罹患者等に対する追検査」を受検することができます。ただし、分割募集を実施する都立高校では、追検査を実施しません。分割前期募集を受検できなかった場合でも、分割後期募集を受検できるためです。

追検査の受検を希望する場合は、中学校長を経由して、「インフルエンザ等学校感染症罹患者等に対する措置申請書」を第一次募集において出願した都立高校へ提出する必要があります(都内の中学校に在学していない場合は、中学校長を経由する必要はありません。)。

なお、追悼を査は第一次募集で受検できなかった高校のみ受検することができます。 出願先を変覚 して受検することはできません。

また、インフルエンザ等の学校感染症や新型コロナウイルス感染症に罹患するなどして、追検査等を受検できなかった場合、追り検査を受検することができます。

Q9. Can I change the school of my choice after submitting my application?

A9. No changes are permitted for applicants for recommendation-based admissions. Changes are permitted (by withdrawing the application and resubmitting it) for applicants for academic achievement test-based admissions in full-time schools. Also, changes are permitted for part-time schools' daytime and night courses at Roppongi, Oedo, Setagaya Izumi, Minorigaoka, Kirigaoka, Odaibashi, Hitotsubashi, Asakusa, Ogikubo, Hachioji Takushin and Sunagawa high schools. Changes are not permitted for any other part-time schools for the first round of admissions, while permitted for the second round of admissions.

Q10. Is there any relief measure for the applicant who was unable to take the examination due to designated school infectious diseases such as influenza or the coronavirus disease?

- A10. If you have a designated school infectious disease such as influenza or a coronavirus disease, or you are suspected of being infected with the coronavirus disease, and as of the date of the examination, are requested to observe your health and refrain from going out as a close contact (*) or are waiting for the result of the PCR test, you will not be able to take the examination.
 - (*) Even if you are a close contact and are requested to observe your health or refrain from going out, if you meet the conditions such as being negative as a result of the PCR test conducted by a doctor at a medical institution that a public health center introduced, you can take the examination in a separate room.

An applicant who was unable to take an academic achievement test-based admission (first round of admissions) can take a "make-up examination for applicants who developed designated school infectious diseases such as influenza," which will be conducted at a later date if submitting an application. However, Tokyo metropolitan high schools which conduct two-phase admissions will not offer the make-up examination. This is because even if you cannot take it in the first phase of application period, you can still take it in the second phase of application period.

If you wish to take the make-up examination, you need to submit a document called "Application form to take a make-up examination for applicants who developed designated school infectious diseases such as influenza" to the high school that you applied to in the first round of admissions via a principal of your junior high school. (If you are not enrolled at a junior high school in Tokyo currently, you do not have to submit it via a principal.)

Please note that you can only take the make-up examination of the high school that you applied to in the first-round admissions: you cannot change the school you apply to.

In addition, if you were unable to take this make-up examination due to a designated school infectious disease such as influenza or the coronavirus disease, you can take additional makeup examination.

- Q11 学力検査の実施日直前に急にけがをしたり病気になったりした場合は、どのような手続をとればよいのでしょうか。
- A11 まず、体調節で受検することが可能か、医師や先生、保護者の方に相談してください。 受検ができるようであり、特別な措置が必要な場合は、在学する中学校を通して出願した高校 に相談し、「事故や病気等による学力検査等実施上の措置申請書」等により、必要な手続きを行ってください(都内の中学校に在学していない場合は、措置申請のための手続き等について、置接、出願した高校に相談してください。)。

Q12 障害のある志願者が受検する場合、どのような制度がありますか。

A12 学力検査、小論文式は作文、面接等において、検査方法、検査時間及び検査会場等についての「特別な措置」を申請することが可能です。志願者の障害の特性等を考慮した上で、問題用紙・解答用紙の拡大、英語リスニングテストでの座席の配慮、別室受検、検査時間の延復、記号選択式での受機、介助者(代望者や音読者などを含む。)の同行、ICT機器の使用などが認められます。

また、通学範囲が限られ、現代ではから通学至便な全日制文は定時制の高校を志願する場合、「選考の特例」を申請することが可能です。

単請は、12月に在学する中学校を通して所定の様式により行うこととなりますので、詳しくは、中学校の先生に確認してください(現在中学校に哲学していない場合は、志願する都立高校に 問い合わせてください。)。

また、気管後の学校生活における配慮について、志願する予定の都立高校に事前に相談することができます。

Q11. What kind of procedure should I take if I get injured or get sick just before the date of the academic achievement test?

A11. First of all, please consult with your doctor, teacher or guardian to see if you can take the test in terms of your physical condition.

If you seem to be able to take the test and need special measures, consult with the high school you applied to through your junior high school and follow the necessary procedures by using the "Application for measures for academic achievement tests due to accidents, illnesses etc." (If you are not enrolled at a junior high school in Tokyo, please consult directly with the high school you applied to regarding the procedures to apply for the measures).

Q12. What types of arrangements can be made for applicants with disabilities taking an entrance examination?

A12. For the academic achievement test, essay or composition and interview portions of the screening, applicants with disabilities can request "special arrangements" with regards to the method of testing, time and venue. Schools will take the characteristics of an applicant's disability into consideration and allow for magnified question/answer sheets, a special seating arrangement in English listening tests, a separate room for taking test, extended time, a multiple-choice test, a caregiver (including a helper to write and read aloud for the student,) use of ICT equipment etc.

In addition, if your commutable range is limited, and you wish to apply to a fulltime or part-time high school that is convenient for commuting from your current address, you can apply to the school by making use of "special measures in selection."

Requests for special arrangements should be made in a prescribed format through the applicant's junior high school that they are enrolled as of December. So, please ask your junior high school teacher for more information. (Applicants who are not currently enrolled at a junior high school may contact the Tokyo metropolitan high school you wish to apply to.)

In addition, you can consult with the Tokyo metropolitan high school you will apply to in advance about the considerations to be given in school life throughout the period of enrollment.

Q13 学力検査問題にルビを振ることができるのは、外国籍の場合だけですか。

A13 国籍を問わず、日本に予国後6年以内で、日本語指導を必要とする志願者は、都立高校共通問題で学力検査を実施する高校を志願する場合、支は、在京外国人生徒対象の高校を志願する場合、 申請により、ひらがなのルビ(ふりがな)を振った検査問題での受検が可能です。

単請は、在学する中学校を選して行うこととなりますので、詳しくは、中学校の先生に確認してください(現在中学校に在学していない場合は、志願する都立高校に問い合わせてください。)。

- Q14 男女別定員制の緩和とはどのような選抜方法ですか。
- A14 全日制普通科で男女別に募集人員を定めている都立高校で、第一次募集・分割前期募集において、第女別募集人員の各9割に相当する人員までを男女別の総合成績の順により合格者として決定し、残りの1割に相当する人員を男女合同の総合成績の順により合格者として決定する選抜方法です。

令和4年度入試では、全日制普通科(コース制・単位制を除く)109校で実施しました。

- Q15 中学校を卒業後、都外へ引っ越すことが決まっていますが、全日制の都立高校に応募できますか。
- A15 応募することはできません。

全日制の都立高校への応募は、都内に保護者(A18の※1参照)と同居し、予後も引き続き都内から通学することが確実であることが案件です。

中学校を卒業後、都外へ引っ越すことが決まっていて公立高校の受検を希望する場合は、引っ越し先の道府県の公立高校に応募することになります。

なお、定時制の都立高校へは、志願者が都内に住所又は勤務先があれば応募することができます。

Q13. Is it only for non-citizens to be able to take an academic achievement test with hiragana rubi?

A13. Regardless of nationality, applicants who need assistance with Japanese language and who have stayed in Japan for less than 6 years are able to take the test with hiragana rubi if the high school of which you wish to take a test conducts academic achievement tests made by Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education, or if you take a test of a high school for foreign students residing in Tokyo based on application.

Applicants need to apply through junior high schools they are enrolled at. So, please ask your junior high school teacher for more information. (If you are not currently enrolled at a junior high school, please contact the Tokyo metropolitan high school you wish to apply to.)

Q14. Please tell me about the easing of gender quotas.

A14. At full-time Tokyo metropolitan high schools offering general education programs that set separate quotas for male and female student openings, the equivalent of 90 percent of openings are filled according to gender, with successful candidates selected in order of overall scores for the first round of admissions/first phase of application period. The remaining 10 percent of successful candidates are selected in order of overall scores, regardless of gender.

For 2022 academic year admissions, 109 full-time schools of general education course (except for the courses with a specialized focus system and credit system) implemented this system.

Q15. We will be moving outside of Tokyo following graduation from junior high school. Can I still apply to enter a full-time Tokyo metropolitan high school?

A15. No, you are not eligible to apply.

Applicants to full-time Tokyo metropolitan high schools must meet the following requirements:

- Applicants must reside in Tokyo with their guardian(s) (See (*1) of A18).
- Applicants must be certain that they will continue to reside in and commute from a residence in Tokyo throughout enrollment in the school.

Those who know they will be moving out of Tokyo upon graduation from junior high school and wish to apply to a public high school will need to apply to a school in the prefecture they are relocating to.

With regards to part-time Tokyo metropolitan high schools, applicants who have an address in Tokyo or whose place of employment is in Tokyo may apply.

- Q16 現在、一家で都外に住んでおり、母とともに都内に転入(炎は単導赴任で別居(都外))する予定ですが、全日制の都立高校に応募できますか。
- A16 A18の「特別の事情(A18の※2参照)」に該当しない場合には、保護者(A18の※1参照)と都内に転入しなければ、空目制の都立高校に応募することはできません。

なお、都立高校に応募する場合には、出顔時に、転居前の道府県の公立高校を志願しないことを 証明する書類・転居を証明する書類などの提出が必要です。

また、定時制の都立高校へは、志願者が都内に住所又は勤務先があれば、応募することができます。

Q17 現在海外に住んでいますが、全日制の都立高校に応募できますか。

A17 自体人学校(在外教育施設)や現地の学校などにおいて、学校教育における9年の課程を修うする見込み支は修うした生徒については、大学自までに保護者(A18の※1参照)と都内に転ってることが確実な場合には、どの都立高校にも応募することができます。

また、主由高校、竹草高校、白野や高校及び国際高校では、一定の応募資格の下、海外帰国生徒等対象の入試(4月入学・9月入学)を実施しています。

- Q16. I currently live outside of Tokyo with my family. My mother and I are planning to move to Tokyo. However, my father is unable to join us and must remain outside of Tokyo alone for business. In this type of situation, am I eligible to apply to a full-time Tokyo metropolitan high school?
- A16. You will not be eligible to apply to a full-time Tokyo metropolitan high school unless you will move to Tokyo with your guardian(s) (see (*1) of A18), and your circumstance falls under "special circumstance" of A18 (See (*2) of A18). When applying to a Tokyo metropolitan high school, you need to submit the documents certifying that you will not apply to a public high school in the prefecture that you reside before relocating and that your address has been changed, etc.

 With regards to part-time Tokyo metropolitan high schools, applicants who have an address in Tokyo or whose place of employment is in Tokyo may apply.

Q17. Although I currently live outside of Japan, is it still possible to apply to a full-time Tokyo metropolitan high school?

A17. Students who are attending a Japanese school (educational institution abroad) or a local school are eligible to apply to any Tokyo metropolitan high school as long as they are expected to complete or have completed the 9 year-course of school education, and it is certain that they will move to Tokyo with their guardian(s) (see (*1) of A18) prior to enrollment.

In addition, under set eligibility requirements, Mita, Takehaya, Hinodai and Kokusai high schools administer entrance examinations for students returning from overseas (April and September enrollment).

For further details, please contact each school or the Tokyo Metropolitan High School Entrance Examination Consultation Corner shown on the back cover of this guide.

Q18 現在都外に住んでいますが、全日制の都立高校に応募できますか。

A18 気学日までに保護者(※1)と都内に転気することが確実な場合には、どの都立高校にも応募することができます。ただし、一時的に都内に転気することがあっても、気学後帯び都外に、志願者、保護者気は志願者と保護者が転居する予定のある場合には、応募することはできません。

また、保護者が交換である場合であって、特別の事情(※2)により交換のどちらか一方が都内に転居できない場合は、その理的を明記するとともに必要な書類を提出して審査を受けた上で、応募資格を認められることがあります。どのような場合でも認められるということではありません。 応募資格や必要な手続の詳細については、義義、紙に記載してある都立高校式試積談コーナーに問い合わせてください。

- ※1 保護者とは、本人に対し親権を行う者であって、原則として父母のことを言います。
- ※2 特別の事情の考え方

「特別の事情」とは、次の(1)~(3)のいずれかに該当する場合です。

- (1) 文与のどちらか一方の整次に転入することができない理点が、介護、湯気療養(艾は出産)のためであり、志願者にとって、都内に転入(在住)する一方の保護者と同居した方が算上盤護を受けられる場合
 - ※ 病気療養については、志願者の保護者及び志願者の兄弟姉妹が病気療養中である場合を対象と します。
- (2) 交換のどちらか一方の<u>都内に転入する理論が、介護のため</u>であり、志願者にとって、都内に転入する一方の保護者と同居した方が身上監護を受けられる場合
- (3) 白茶菌籍を育する志願者の炎辱のどちらか一方の<u>都内に志願者と同居できない理問が、海外勤務の継続のため</u>であり、志願者にとって、海外から都内に転えては都内に在住する一方の保護者と同意した方が身上監護を受けられる場合。ただし、炎母の電方が帰国できない場合は、保護者に代わる都内在住の身荒引受人がいること、保護者(保護者が炎母である場合は、炎艾は母の一方でよい。)が志願者のうう学後1年以内に帰国し、都内に志願者と同居することが必要です。

Q18. I currently live outside of Tokyo. Can I apply to a full-time Tokyo metropolitan high school?

- **A18.** If it is certain that you and your guardian(s) (*1) will move to Tokyo prior to enrollment, you may apply to any Tokyo metropolitan high school. However, applicants and/or guardians who temporarily relocate to Tokyo but have plans to relocate outside of Tokyo after enrolled are not eligible to apply.
 - Furthermore, in the case the applicant's guardians are his/her parents, if one or the other cannot relocate to Tokyo due to special circumstances (*2), the applicant needs to clarify the reason for this and submit a necessary document to be examined. His/her application may then be approved. Please note that not all cases are approved.

For details on the eligibility and necessary procedures, please contact the Tokyo Metropolitan High School Entrance Examination Consultation Corner shown on the back cover of this guide.

- * 1) Guardians mean those who exercise parental authority over an applicant, and they indicate the mother and father as a rule.
- * 2) Regarding "special circumstances"

"Special circumstances" herein mean when the case falls under either one of the following 1) to 3).

- 1) In case where either an applicant's mother or father cannot move to Tokyo <u>in order</u> to provide nursing care or receive medical treatment for diseases (or give birth), and the applicant can receive more personal supervision if he/she lives with the other parent who moves to (resides in) Tokyo.
 - * "Receiving medical treatment" herein means the case where the applicant's guardians or siblings are under medical treatment.
- 2) In case where either an applicant's mother or father moves to Tokyo due to nursing care, and the applicant can receive more personal supervision if he/she lives with the parent who moves to Tokyo.
- * "Nursing-care" herein means taking care of a relative within the second degree of kinship who is certified as level 2 to 5 of long-term care need. Long-term care need level 1 and support need level 1 to 2 are not applicable.
- 3) In case where either a mother or father of an applicant who has Japanese nationality is unable to live in Tokyo with the applicant <u>due to continuation of overseas assignment</u>, and the applicant can receive more personal supervision if he/she lives with the other parent who moves from overseas/resides in Tokyo. However, when neither of his/her parents can return to Japan, the applicant needs to live under the care of a guarantor, who resides in Tokyo and acts as his/her guardian. In addition, the applicant's parents need to return to Japan and live with the applicant in Tokyo within a year after his/her enrollment. (If parents are the guardians, it is not necessary for both the mother and father to live with the applicant, but either of them needs to live with him/her.)

- ★ 応募資格が認められる事例
- 事例2 印学3年里である志願者は、一家でB県に在催している。都内に在催する母先の植場が姜介護3 の認定を受けたので、母は祖母を介護するため、都内の祖母宅で同居することとした。 交は仕事の関係でB県に残らなければならないことから、交及び母は、志願者が母と同居する方が身上監護を受けられると判断し、伊学校卒業を機に、志願者は母と都内の祖母等で同居することとした。

Cases where a student is eligible for application

- Case 1: A third-year junior high school applicant lives in Prefecture A with his/her whole family including a grandfather who is certified as level 5 of long-term care need. The applicant's father is assigned to work in Tokyo and moves to Tokyo by himself because it is difficult for him to commute to the workplace from Prefecture A. Since the applicant's mother continuously needs to devote herself to grandfather's care, his/her parents determine that the applicant can receive more personal supervision by living with his/her father, and the applicant has decided to live with him in Tokyo upon graduation from junior high school.
- Case 2: A third-year junior high school applicant lives in Prefecture B with his/her whole family. Since his/her maternal grandmother living in Tokyo is certified as level 3 of long-term care need, his/her mother will live with his/her grandmother in Tokyo to take care of her, while his/her father has to stay in Prefecture B due to his work. His/her parents determine that the applicant can receive more personal supervision by living with his/her mother, and the applicant has decided to live with her in his/her grandmother's house in Tokyo upon graduation from junior high school.
- Case 3: A third-year junior high school applicant lives with his/her whole family including his/her grandmother in Prefecture C. While his/her mother is hospitalized to receive medical treatment in Prefecture C, his/her father is assigned to work in Tokyo. Since it is difficult for him to commute to the workplace from Prefecture C, he moved to Tokyo by himself. Because his/her mother will be continuously hospitalized even after April 1, 2023 in Prefecture C, his/her parents determine that the applicant can receive more personal supervision by living with his/her father, and the applicant has decided to live with him in Tokyo upon graduation from junior high school. His/her mother will move to Tokyo as soon as she recovers from her illness.
- * Details of the application for the eligibility screening and documents to be submitted will be announced in early November in the "Outline of the application for the eligibility screening for Tokyo Metropolitan High Schools of the 2023 academic year."

Q19 外国籍の場合、都立高校に応募できますか。

、 **A19** 都立高校への応募資格を満たせば、どの都立高校にも応募することができます。

なお、日本に気菌後3年以内の外国籍の志願者は、志願する高校が都立高校詳通問題で学力検査を実施する場合、申請により、ひらがなのルビ(ふりがな)を振った学力検査問題(共通問題)

支はひらがなのルビ(ふりがな)を振った学力検査問題(共通問題)に加えて許書の持込み及び学力検査時間の延長での受検が可能です(ただし、国語の学力検査では許書の持込み及び学力検査時間の延長はありません。)。日本に気菌後3年を超えていても、気菌後6年以内であれば、ひらがなのルビ(ふりがな)を振った検査問題での受検は可能です(A13参照)。

また、竹合高校、由橋高校、南葛飾高校、府中西高校、飛鳥高校、六郷工科高校、杉並総合高校 及び国際高校では、一定の応募資格の下、在京外国人生徒対象の入試(4月入学・9月入学(六郷工科高校及び杉並総合高校を除く。))を実施しています。ただし、国際高校以外の7校のいずれかの高校に合格した場合は、入学手続を行っていなくても、後日検査を実施する国際高校に応募することはできません。

Q19. I am not a citizen of Japan. Am I eligible to apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school?

A19. As long as you meet the eligibility requirements for the application for a Tokyo metropolitan high school, you are eligible to apply.

Those who are not citizens of Japan and less than three years has passed since he/she entered Japan may apply to take an academic achievement test with hiragana rubi (furigana) to aid with reading if the high school conducts academic achievement tests made by Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education. Besides, he/she may be allowed to bring in a dictionary and have extended time when taking the academic achievement test with hiragana rubi (furigana). (However, for a Japanese academic achievement test, he/she is not allowed to bring in any dictionary and have extended time.) If he/she has stayed in Japan for 3 years or more but less than 6 years, then he/she can also take the test with hiragana rubi (See **A13**).

In addition, under set eligibility requirements, Takenodai, Tagara, Minami Katsushika, Fuchu Nishi, Asuka, Rokugo Koka, Suginami Sogo and Kokusai high schools hold entrance examinations for foreign students residing in Tokyo for April and September enrollment (no September enrollment for Rokugo Koka and Suginami Sogo high schools.) However, in the case a candidate is accepted by any of the seven high schools besides Kokusai high school, he/she may not apply to Kokusai high school, which will hold the examination at a later date, even if the candidate does not complete the admission procedure of the accepted school.

Q20 島しょの中学校から、島しょ以外の都立高校(全日制)に応募できますか。

A20 予学日までに、保護者(保護者が交換である場合は交換では交換のどちらか一方)とともに転贈するか、保護者に代わる島しょ以外の都防に程程の勇売引受人(成人の親族等)のもとに転贈することが確実な場合には、島しょ以外の都立高校に応募することができます。

なお、 身元引受人には学生寮等の寮長(寮に常駐しており、保護者の役割をになえる者)も含みます。

Q21 島しょ以外の中学校から、島しょの都立高校(全日制)に応募できますか。

A21 気管白までに、保護者とともに島しょに転居するか、保護者に代わる島しょに在催の勇売引要人のもとに転居することが確実な場合には、島しょの都立高校に応募することができます。

また、島しょの野科が強首に実施する島外生徒受入選考に合格した場合についても、島しょの都 立高校に応募することができます。

なお、一部の島しょの町村において、入学前に島しょの自然体験活動や高校見学ができる中学生対象の島しょ体験ショートステイを実施します。募集の詳細は東京都教育委員会ホームページで公表しています。

Q22 定時制文は通信制の都立高校に応募するには、どのような条件がありますか。

A22 定時制に応募するには、まず、中学校を卒業する見込みであるか既に卒業したことが必要です。その上で、都内に住所もしくは勤務先を育し、、次学後も引き続き都内に住所もしくは勤務先を育することが確実な方式は入学日までに都内に住所もしくは勤務先を育することが確実な方式は入学日までに都内に住所もしくは勤務先を育することが確実で、入学後も引き続き都内に住所もしくは勤務先を育することが確実な方が応募資格を育します。

通信制の応募資格は、上記に該当しかつ当該都立高校が実施する面接指導(スクーリング)に 対応(出席)可能な方となります。

Q20. Can a student enrolled at a junior high school on one of Tokyo's islands apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school (full-time) on the mainland?

A20. A student may apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school on the mainland if it is certain that he/she can relocate with his/her guardian(s) (if the guardians are his/her parents, both the mother and father or either of them,) or he/she will live under the care of a "guarantor" (adult relative, etc.) who resides in Tokyo (on the mainland) and will act as his/her guardian prior to enrollment.

A student dormitory director (who is always stationed and acts as a guardian) may also serve as a guarantor.

Q21. Can a student enrolled at a junior high school on the mainland apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school (full-time) on one of Tokyo's islands?

A21. A student may apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school on one of Tokyo's islands if it is certain that he/she can relocate with his/her guardian(s), or he/she will live under the care of a "guarantor" (adult relative) who resides in the Tokyo's island and will act as his/her guardian prior to enrollment.

In addition, a student who passed the selection for acceptance of students from outside Tokyo's islands, which is implemented by towns and villages of Tokyo's islands on their own, may also apply to a Tokyo metropolitan high school on one of Tokyo's islands.

Furthermore, some towns or villages of Tokyo's islands will offer the opportunity for junior high school students to experience a short stay in Tokyo's islands so that they can participate in nature-experience activities and visit high schools before enrollment. The details of the application have been announced on the Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education website.

Q22. What are the conditions for applying to a part-time or correspondence metropolitan high school?

A22. To apply to a part-time school, you must first be expected to graduate or have graduated from junior high school. On top of that, those who have an address or place of employment in Tokyo and are certain to have an address or place of employment in Tokyo after enrollment, or those who are certain to have an address or place of employment in Tokyo by the date of enrollment and are certain to continue to have an address or place of employment in Tokyo after enrollment are eligible to apply.

The eligibility for applying to a correspondence school are those who fall under the above and can respond to (attend) the interview guidance (schooling) conducted by such metropolitan high schools.

Q23 中学校での欠席が多い場合、欠席の事情を都立高校に説明できると聞きましたが、どのような方法が ありますか。

A23 伝えたい及席の事情を「首己皆告書」の角紙に記えし、出願時に志願する高校へ提出することで、事情を説明することができます。「首己皆告書」の角紙は、都立高校等の窓口で配布します。 守学校からの配布を希望する場合は、守学校の先生に掲談してください。

自己始告書は、お願者及び保護者が記入し、厳封して、入学願書等の出願書類とともにお願する都立高校に提出することになります。

Q24 首 PRカードとはどのようなものですか。


A24 自己PRカードは、志望理論や谐さんが で学校で取り組んできた学習や様々な活動 から得たことなど、志望校に最も伝えたい ことを記入して提出するものです。

直包PRカードを流数化することはありませんが、簡接を行う場合の簡接資料や気 試の合格判定資料の一部として活用したり、学校生活に対する意欲等を確認したりする資料になります。

面接を実施する高校を志願する場合は、 この自己PRカードを出願時に志願する高 校へ提出します。

面接を実施しない高校を志願する場合は、 入学手続後に入学する高校へ提出し、 入学系統後に入学する高校へ提出し、 入学後の個人面談等で使用します。





※チャレンジスクールの答学校に出願する場合は、首白PRカードの代わりに、答学校所定の「志願的告書」を提出します。


- Q23. I understand that if I have a poor attendance record at junior high school, I can have the opportunity to explain the circumstances surrounding my absences to the Tokyo metropolitan high school. How do I go about doing this?
- **A23.** You can explain it by filling in a "Personal Declaration Form" to convey the reason behind your absences and submitting it to the high school you wish to apply to at the time of application. Forms are available at Tokyo metropolitan high schools and related offices. If you wish to obtain a form at your junior high school, please consult with your teacher.


Q24. What is a self-introduction card?

A24. A self-introduction card should be filled in with what you want to convey the most to the high school you will apply to such as what you have learned and gained through study and various activities in your junior-high-school life. The self-introduction card will not be scored. However, it is used as reference for the interview test and a part of the resources to make a pass/fail judgement for the entrance examination and to see the applicant's motivation toward his/her school life.

If you apply to a high school which conducts an interview test, you need to submit this self-introduction card to the high school you will apply to at the time of application.

If you apply to a high school that does not conduct interview tests, you need to submit it to the high school you are admitted to after completing the entrance procedure so that the school will use it for personal interviews, etc. following admission.





* If you apply to one of the Challenge schools, you need to submit "Declaration for Application" designated by each school instead of this self-introduction card.

Summarize your learning and other activities of your junior high school life.

Q25 合格発表後、学力検査等の得益を知りたい場合や、学力検査における自分自身の答案を見たい場合は、どのようにすればよいですか。

A25 入試における透明性の確保を首節として、「本人得点の開示」及び「学力検査における答案の開示」の制度があります。

開示請求の受付は、3月から(合格者は5月から)8月までの期間となります。開示請求書を受検した高校に提出し、本人確認ができるもの(受検票や身分証明書など)を提示することにより、学力検査等の得点が記載された表や学力検査における答案の写しを受け取ることができます(保護者が開示請求する場合は、受検票と保護者の歴史ができるものの両方の提示が必要です。)。また、窓口での申請に加えて、電子での申請も行えます。

手続の方法などについては、11月上旬に発行予定の「令和5年度東京都立高等学校募集案 内」で確認してください。

- Q25. If I want to know my score on the academic achievement tests, etc. or want to see my answer sheets after the exam results have been announced, what should I do?
- A25. There are systems of "Disclosure of a Candidate's Score" and "Disclosure of Answer Sheets of an Academic Achievement Test" with the objective of ensuring the transparency in academic achievement tests.

 Requests are responded to from March to August (while for successful

Requests are responded to from March to August (while for successful candidates, from May to August.)

You may receive a score sheet of your achievement test, etc. or a copy of your answer sheets for an academic achievement test after the results have been announced by submitting a disclosure request to the high school where the test was taken and by presenting some form of identification (such as your admission ticket or ID.) (If your guardian requests the disclosure, both your admission ticket and your guardian's ID are required.) You can also request electronically in addition to requesting at the counter.
