●転学(学びの場の柔軟な見直し)について

就学時に小学校6年間、中学校3年間の学びの場が全て決まるのではなく、お子さまの発達の様子や学校の環境等を考えながら、年度替わりの時期を原則として柔軟 there is flexibility for a child's school placement to change at the start of a new school year (this is also called a school transfer) while taking the child's に転学(※転校ともいう。)することができます。

Do you have any concerns regarding your child's enrollment in elementary school?

If you have concerns, you should talk to us about them. The Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education and the municipal boards of education work together with parents and guardians on issues regarding their children's education and school placement.

• Determining your child's place of learning (school placement) Information-sharing and consultations for children and parents/guardians (orientation sessions, interviews, school tours, class observation, etc.)

Considering school placement from a comprehensive viewpoint

(disability status: opinions of the child, parents/guardians, and specialists; school and community conditions; etc.)

The municipal board of education makes the final decision on school placement.

School placement (flexible assessments regarding the child's place of learning)

The child's place of learning for all six elementary school years and all three junior high school years are not finalized when the child enrolls in school. Rather, developmental progress, school environment, and other factors into consideration

If you wish to change schools after enrollment, we ask that you first consult with a teacher at the school where your child is enrolled.

 Q&A regarding school placement consultations Q: I am concerned about my child's learning and behavior. Who should I talk to regarding school placement? A: Please contact the municipal board of education where you live

Q: I have been told by others that I should talk to someone about school placement. Is that a good idea? A: You should take this opportunity to discuss the support, care, and educational environment your child needs to help your child adjust to school life. Please bring your child when you come.

Q: Can I send my child to a local elementary school near my home even if he/she has a disability? care your child needs for school life is something all parties should consider together.

Q: I am concerned that attending a special needs school will cause my child to lose/her connection with the community and with his/her friends. A: Children and students enrolled in special needs schools maintain secondary enrollment at a local elementary or junior high school, allowing them to connect the community and their friends.

In order for parents/guardians and the board of education to reach a consensus on school placement, a series of interviews will take place for the following purposes. Checking the child's condition The school placement counselor who assists you will visit your child's day care or kindergarten to observe the child's day-to-day situation

 Touring the desired school and observing classes Tours and class observation provide opportunities for parents/guardians and the school placement counselor to see what daily life is like for childrer

+ Health examination by a physician (health checkup at the start of school), developmental testing, etc.

Your child's condition will be reviewed from a professional viewpoint, and we will work with you to determine what support your child needs

November to January

Decision regarding school placement (The child's parents/guardians will receive a notification from the municipal board of education.)

February to March Orientation session for children who intend to enroll (The school will notify the parents/guardians regarding the specifics.)

April Entrance ceremony
