(注1) 平成26年度入学生から、高等学校等就学支援金制度が導入されました。就学支援金制度とは、区市町村民税の課税標準額×6%－区市町村民税の調整控除の額(※)が304,200円未満(年収目安約910万円未満)の世帯の生徒が申請を行い、受給認定された場合、学校に就学支援金を支給することで、その生徒の授業料等が無料になる制度です。返済の必要はありません。ただし、支給手続を行わない場合は、授業料をご負担いただくこととなります。

また、既に高校を卒業したことがある方及び修業年限(全日制36か月、定時制48か月)を超えて在学している方については、就学支援金の対象者とならないため、原則として授業料を徴収します。

※ 政令指定都市の場合は、調整控除の額に3/4を乗じて計算します。

(注2) 令和6年度から、所得制限により就学支援金の適用外となった生徒については、授業料免除の申請を行っていただくことで、授業料を全額免除します。詳細は入学が決定した際に、入学予定の学校にお問い合わせください。

※ 所得制限以外の理由(在学期間等)により就学支援金が適用外となった場合は免除の対象外です。

(注3) 授業料の納入回数は2回ですが、分割払いとすることも可能です。

※ 入学料及び授業料の納入が経済的に困難な家庭については、免除又は2分の1に減額する制度があります。

## 7. Entrance Examination Fee and Tuition Fee

### (1) Entrance Examination Fee, Admission Fee and Tuition Fee

(Note 1) **The Tuition Support System for High Schools, etc.** has been adopted for students who entered high school in or after April 2014 academic year. The Tuition Support Fund System aims to support a student in a household with the municipal standard taxable income multiplied by 6% after subtracting municipal income tax adjusted deduction (※) below 304,200 yen (or below an annual income of about 9,100,000 yen). If a student in an eligible household applies and his/her application is approved, the tuition support fund is provided to the student's school to offer the student free tuition, etc. Repayment is not required.

**However, if no application for the support is filed, the tuition fees need to be paid.**

In addition, students who have already graduated from high school or have attended school for a period exceeding the term of study (36 months for full-time and 48 months for part-time) are not eligible for this tuition support, and tuition is collected as a rule.

※In the case of ordinance-designated cities, it is calculated by multiplying the amount of adjusted deduction by 3/4.

(Note 2) **Since 2024, for the students not applicable for the tuition support due to income restrictions, the system of total exemption is available based on application for exemption of tuition fees.**

For details, when your admission to a Tokyo metropolitan high school is determined, contact the high school you are to be enrolled.

※In of a student not applicable for the tuition support by reason other than income restrictions (period of school attendance etc.), he/she is not eligible for such exemption of tuition fees.

(Note 3) Tuition payment should be made in two installments, but payment by more installments is also available.

**※For families with financial difficulties in paying the admission fee and tuition fee, a system of exemption or reduction by 50% is available.**

(2) 奨学のための給付金について

高校では、入学料及び授業料とは別に、学校ごとに決定した修学旅行等積立金、生徒会費、定時制の給食費等の学校徴収金の徴収があります。

平成26年度入学生から、授業料・通信教育受講料以外の教育に必要な経費（教科書費、教材費、学用品費、通学用品費、教科外活動費、生徒会費等）の負担を軽減するため、高校生等がいる生活保護受給世帯又は都道府県民税所得割額及び区市町村民税所得割額が非課税の世帯を対象に奨学のための給付金の認定を受けた方に給付金を支給しています。返済の必要はありません。

(2) Benefits for Expenses Other than Tuition

Other than admission fee and tuition fee, high schools collect some fees for school activities such as reserve funds for excursions, expenses for student council activities, school meal fees for part-time course etc., which are determined by each school.

In order to reduce the burden of school related expenses other than tuition fee and correspondence tuition (such as expenses for textbooks, educational materials school supplies, supplies necessary for commuting to school, extra-curricular activities and student council activities) the scholarships are offered to high school students in households on welfare support or prefectural and municipal tax-free households and who entered high school in or after April 2014 academic year if it is approved. Repayment of the benefit is not required.

(3) 給付型奨学金について

平成29年度から、家庭の経済状況にかかわらず、誰もが安心して学び、もてる可能性を最大限伸ばすことができるよう、学習の成果を明らかにする資格試験や学校における勉強合宿・語学合宿等の教育活動にかかる経費等を、保護者の代わりに負担する都独自の現物給付方式の奨学金制度が導入されました。

支給対象者は、都立高校等に在籍する生徒のうち、以下の条件に該当する方です。

※ 上記世帯の生徒が申請を行い、受給認定されることにより、生徒が通う学校の教育活動にかかる経費にあてるものとして支給する制度です。返済の必要はありません。ただし、学校の教育活動に参加しない場合は支給対象となりません。

具体的な対象経費については学校によって異なりますので、詳細は入学が決定した際に、入学予定の学校に問い合わせてください。

(3) Scholarship with no repayment required

Since the 2017 academic year, the Tokyo Metropolitan Government has adopted its own scholarship system so that all students can learn without any worries and maximize their capability and potential regardless of the financial situation of each household. This system, a type of providing benefit in kind has covered the expenses for educational activities such as certification examinations to demonstrate students' learning outcomes, study camps, language-learning camps at schools etc. on behalf of their guardians.

The recipient must be a student at a Tokyo metropolitan high school and must meet the conditions below:

※ This is the system where the fund is provided to a student in a household described above to cover the expenses for the educational activities of the school that the student attends if the student applies and is approved to receive the fund. Repayment of the fund is not required. **However, if a student does not participate in the school educational activities, the fund is not provided.**

The specific activities for which expenses should be covered vary in each school. Therefore, when admission is granted, please inquire for details with the school where the student to be enrolled.

◎ 受験生チャレンジ支援貸付事業のご案内

中学3年生等の受験生を養育する一定所得以下の世帯を対象に、学習塾代や受験料に必要な資金を貸し付けることにより、子供たちの進学を支援します。

<概要>

- 1 対象 中学3年生又はこれに準じる方を養育する一定所得以下の世帯の生計中心者
- 2 貸付内容 塾代及び受験料の貸付を行い、進学（入学）した場合は償還を免除します。
- 3 貸付金額等 塾代 上限200,000円、受験料 上限27,400円（4校まで）  
※ 受験料は、都立高校入学考査料のほか、私立高校等の受験料も対象です。  
ただし、1校あたり上限23,000円です。
- 4 貸付利率 無利子
- 5 申込方法 お住まいの区市町村の窓口にお問い合わせの上、お申し込みください。

◎ Information on the loan project to support students taking entrance examination

This is a supporting project for students who wish to go to high schools by loaning the necessary funds for cram school fees and examination fees to households that raise students taking entrance examination such as third-year junior high school students with incomes below a certain level.

<Overview>

1. Available to: The biggest earner of the household with a certain income or less that raises third-year junior high school students or those who are similar
2. Loan details: Loaning the cram school fee and the examination fee, and **if a student is admitted (enrolled), he/she will be exempt from reimbursement.**
3. Loan amount, etc.: Upper limit for the cram school fee is 200,000 yen, and for examination fee, 27,400 yen (up to 4 schools).  
※The examination fee includes the entrance fee for metropolitan high schools as well as that for private high schools.  
However, the upper limit is 23,000 yen per school.
4. Loan interest rate: Interest-free
5. How to apply: Please contact your municipalities and apply.

<Loan Requirements>

○The total income or total income after deduction of the household (caregivers such as parents) must be below a certain level.
